



Tour to Nuratau (extended2)



4 days / 3 nights

Duration: 4 Days/3 nights

Route: Samarkand->Nuratau Mountains->Yurt Camp->Bukhara

Description: This four days trip starting from Samarkand and ending in Bukhara welcomes you to discover the mountain and desert landscapes of Uzbekistan along with its overwhelmingly hospitable rural people living in the remote Nuratau Mountain villages. You will be staying with the mountain farmers in homestays where there is a great opportunity to interact with locals and learn about their culture, traditions and daily life. You will also have a chance to see some local sites during the day's hike on the second day of the tour. The tour is also complemented with an overnight stay in a desert yurt camp, camel riding and visit to the Lake Aydarkul. In Nuratau city, we stop to see Alexander the Great's fortress ruins, local Suzani workshop and Cahshma Mosque.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 8:00 Breakfast ▪ 9:00 Depart from Yurt Camp via Nurata to Bukhara ▪ 10:00 Stopover in Nurata and see the ruins of Alexander the Great's fortress, local Suzani workshop and Chashma Mosque ▪ 11:00 Continue to Bukhara ▪ 14:00 Arrive to Bukhara
